

Waiting In Line




There are hidden rules for how to wait in line.




Give others personal space.




If you imagine a hula hoop around your body, this is how much space you need.





Keep your hands to yourself. Do not touch other people.




Wait quietly.








Have a calm body. This will help others feel comfortable around you.




Keep your eyes to yourself.




Staring at other people in line can make them feel uncomfortable.




When people do not follow the hidden rules of waiting in line,
