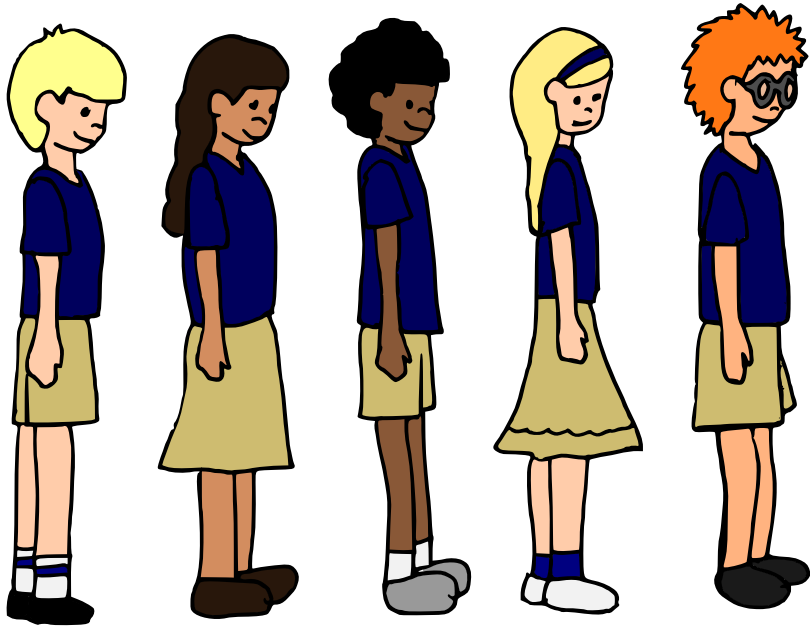
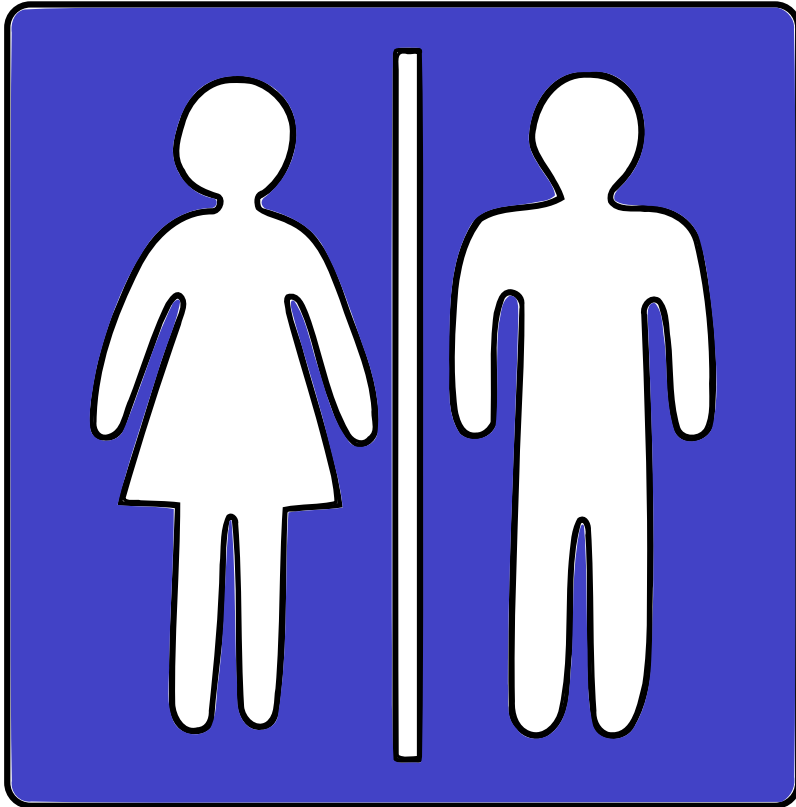

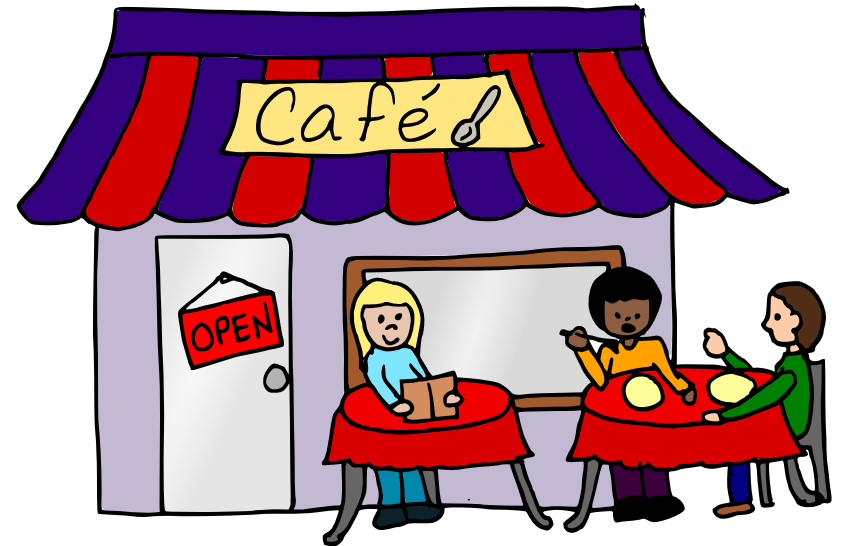


We all wait in lines

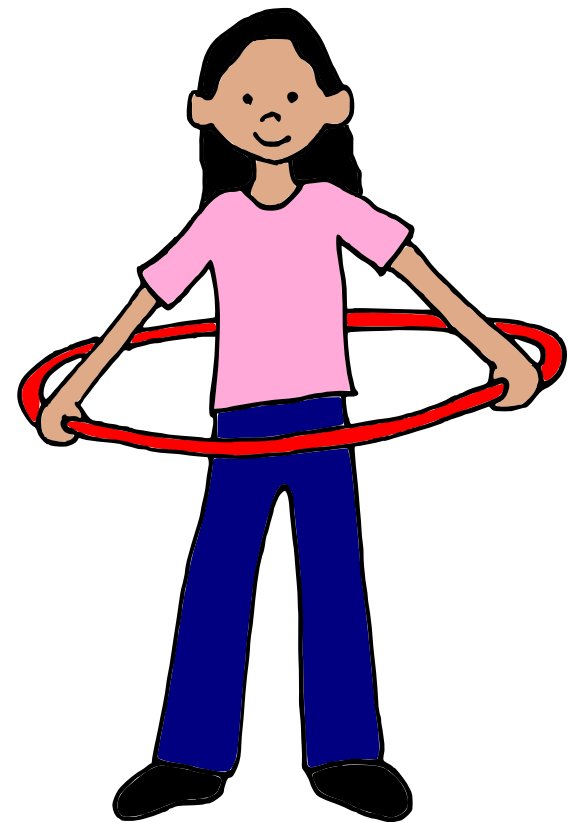

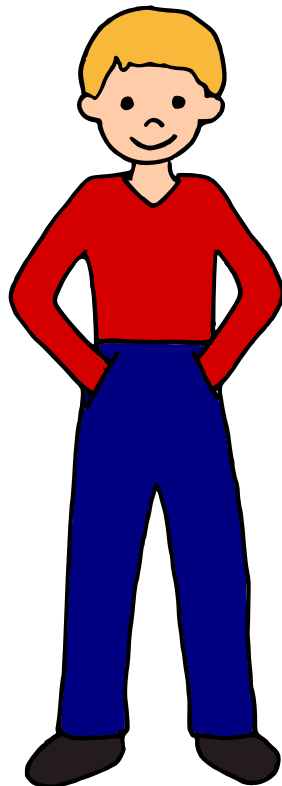
There are hidden rules
for how to wait in line.



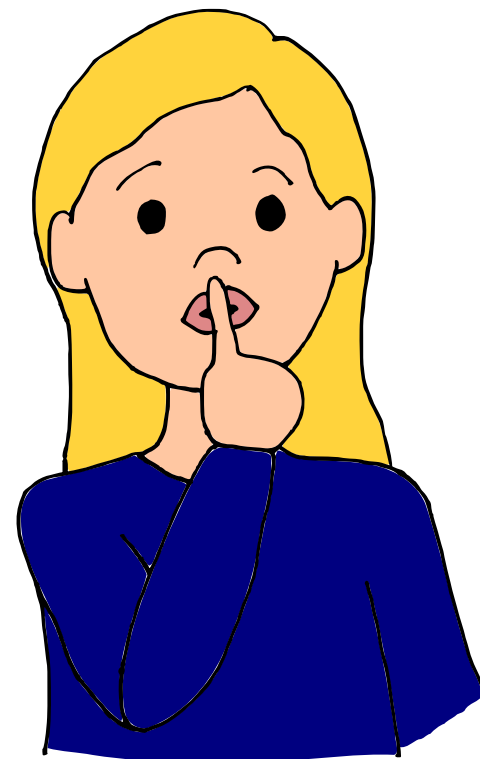
Give others personal
space.



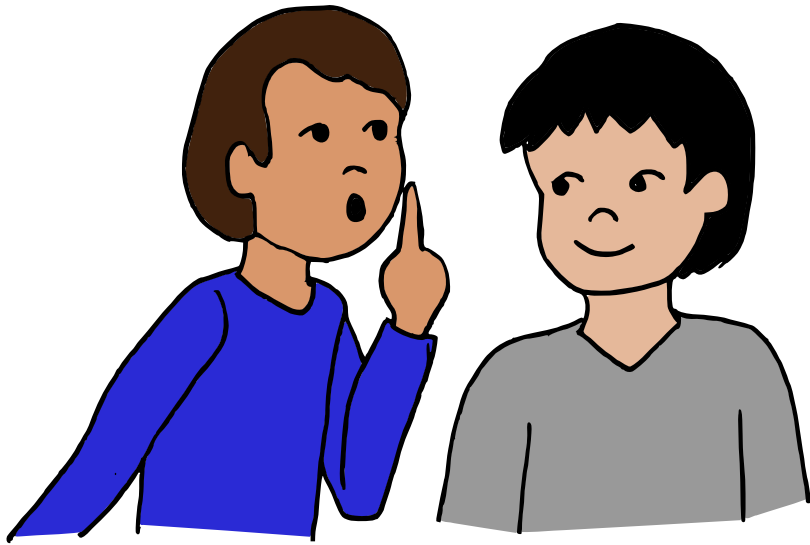
If you imagine a hula

you need.



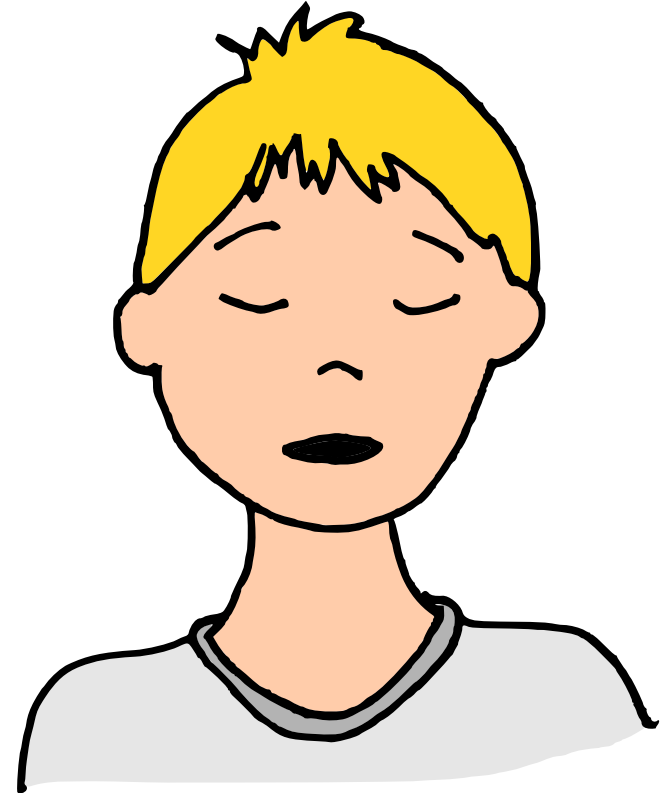
Keep your hands to

other people.



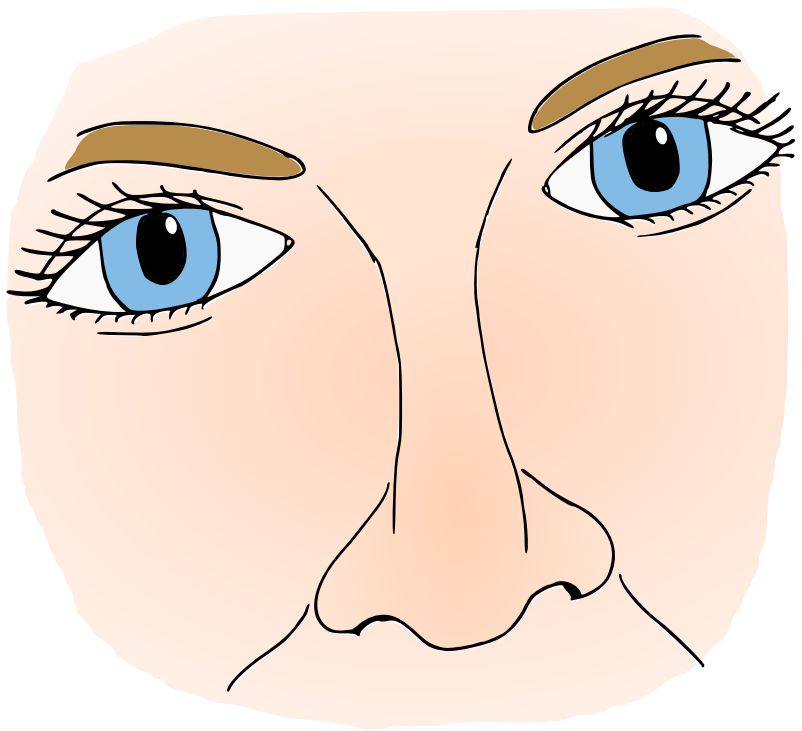
Wait quietly.



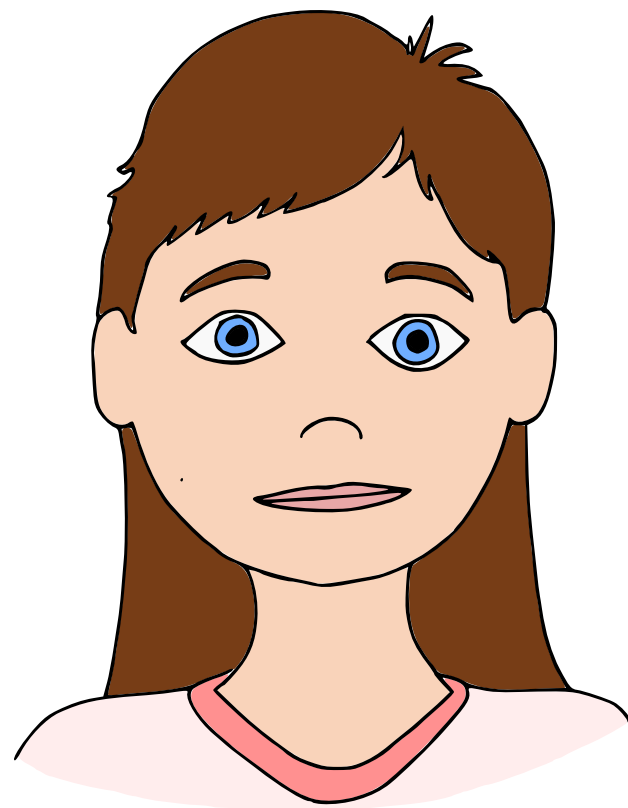
If you need to talk to others, use a quiet voice.



Have a calm body. This will help others feel comfortable around you.



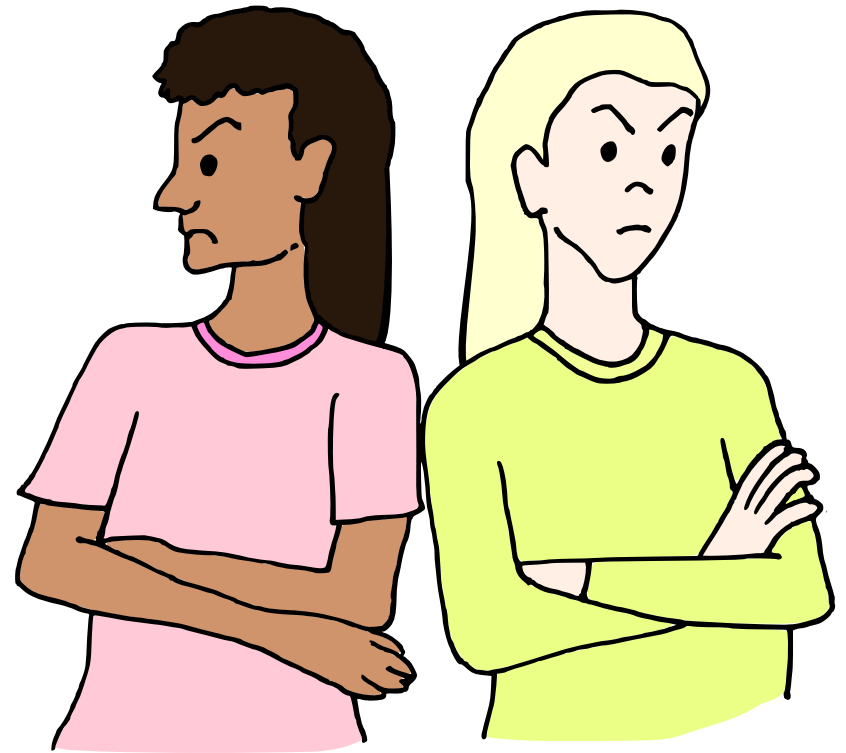
Keep your eyes to

feel uncomfortable.



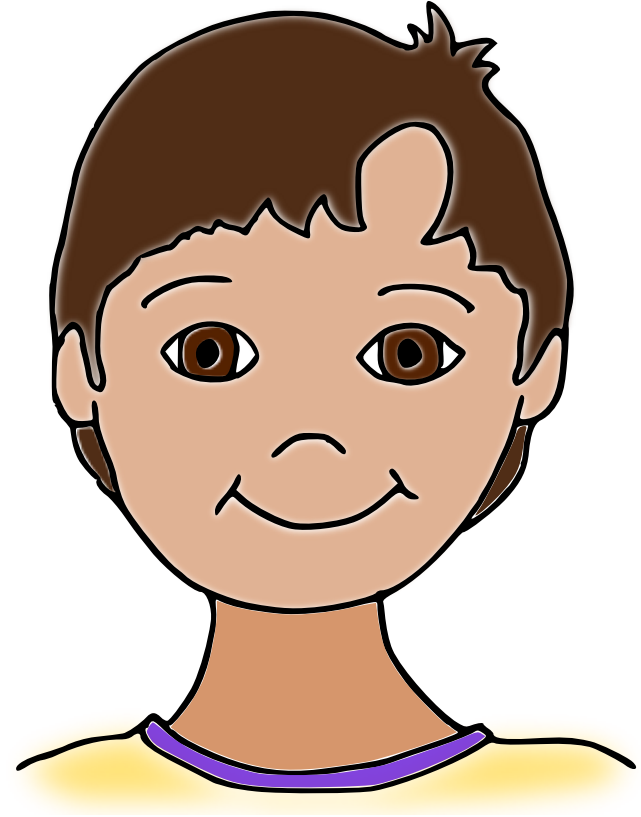
When people do not follow the hidden rules of waiting in line,
